ISOC's first visit to the Western Nationals at the Rio Tinto Stadium in Salt Lake City, Utah turned out to be a great success. The races were very exciting as nearly 10,000 people cheered on the riders under the stadium lights of the newly built soccer stadium. The track was tight and the races were close, thus providing a nickname for the race as the Talladega of Snocross.

Kurt #318 was the sole rider from Bauerly Racing to represent the team out west. The rest of the team stayed home for the weekend and focused on testing and training. The elevation proved to be tough to adjust to, but Kurt acting as rider and mechanic was able to pull together some promising results.

Through qualifying Kurt pulled off two 4th place finishes which landed him a spot on the front row of the final. In the Semi Pro #1 Final, Kurt was the only Ski-doo rider to qualify for the big show. At the start, Kurt got pushed wide around the first corner putting him in about 11th place. After charging through 16 tough laps, Kurt was able to pass a few other riders to secure himself a respectable 7th place finish overall. If it wasn't for the bad start Kurt would have most likely found himself running up front.

The team has the next weekend off and will be doing a lot of testing to be sure that charge to the front will happen.
