The last stop on the AMSOIL Championship Snocross Series was held at the gorgeous Lake Geneva Resort in Lake Geneva, WI. This is the most exciting, highflying event of the year. With the most challenging track ISOC has seen all year, it was an awesome event for racers and fans alike.

Team Bauerly Racing started the weekend off with Kurt running in the Semi-Pro Super Stock 1 class on Friday. The sun was out and the weather reached into the high 50's. Kurt put in hard rides during qualifying to lock down a spot in the final. As the anticipation of the finals approached, so did the end of the day. With there being over 70 heat races they were not able to get all the races in, which moved Kurt's final to Saturday morning. Kurt got a good jump off the line putting him in 4th place, but a tangle at the top of the hill put him towards the back. Kurt rode hard and moved up in the pack and took a solid 9th place finish, locking him into 10th place in overall national season points for the year.

Tom took over the rest of Saturday on his open mod sled. In qualifying he rode hard and put in two great qualifying rounds finishing 2nd and 4th. This locked him up a spot for the big show on Saturday evening as the 7th qualifier. In the final, he rocked off the line putting him in the 4th position. He rode hard but the track was tough and some mistakes later on in the race put him into a respectable 9th place in the end. With this finish, he was able to keep his 9th place in overall national points.

Sunday brought the whole team together for the final day of the Nielsen Enterprises Grand Finale. Chad and Scott started the morning off in the Pro Plus 30 Super Stock Class. Chad rode two very solid rounds of qualifying taking a 3rd and a 2nd. Scott put in two respectable rides finishing 4th and 5th. With these solid performances it put both Scott and Chad into the final. Chad got a great start off the line and was first up the hill, but a unfortunate incident put him towards the back of the pack. He charged hard and rode all the way back up to 5th place overall. Scott put in a good performance against the tough competition and landed himself a nice 10th place finish. Chad finished the year in 2nd place overall in points, and Scott was 7th.

Kurt and Tom both rode in the Semi-pro Super Stock #2 class. The competition was fierce and both riders had some bad luck during the qualifying heats. Kurt was running a solid 3rd place when with about 3 laps to go he had motor troubles and pulled off in round 1. Tom was in the same heat as Kurt but got tangled with another rider in the first lap causing him to flip over and finish 7th. The next round of qualifying found the riders in separate heat races with Kurt up first. He had a great start and pulled a 3rd place off the line. Kurt put in one of his best rides of the season and charged hard running down both riders in front of him. He found himself with one lap to go and a victory in sight. With about half-track to go the 2nd place rider sucked up next to Kurt in the corner and put a block pass on him causing him to flip his sled in the corner. Kurt got up to finish the race but with a bad run in both classes, this ended his chances of making the final. Tom put in a solid 6th place finish but it just was not enough to get into the final round.
