A Vessel Safety Check or Vessel Inspection is a voluntary thing to do to make sure your boat is up to U.S. Coast Guard standards. The folks doing the safety checks are volunteers and do not “work” for the U.S. Coast Guard, but are volunteers of the **U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary**. Upon successful completion of the Safety Check you will receive a sticker to put on your boat. In essence, having the safety sticker on your boat tells everyone that you care about safety and your boat has passed the inspection.

Here is a link to tell you about the process and why some boats don't pass. Please know if your boat does not pass you are not in trouble and you can have another inspection to bring your boat up to passing. <http://www.safetyseal.net/>
