## **Broiler Starter**

### **M0510**

#### **Guaranteed Analysis**

CRUDE PROTEIN	not less than	20.0%
CRUDE FAT	not less than	6.5 %
CRUDE FIBER	not more than	4.0 %

#### **Feed Description:**

Natures Best Broiler Starter is a 20% Crude Protein feed designed to get broiler or backyard layer chicks off to a good start. It will enhance good livability, good legs, and early feathering, and will provide the building blocks for economical weight gains.

#### **How to Feed:**

Natures Best Broiler Starter should be made available in chick feeders or feeder lids when chicks arrive. Keep feed in front of the birds at all times. Granite grit may be fed in small amounts, (a handful for 200 chicks on top of starter feed). Clean water should be available at all times.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

Chicks will consume approximately 2 -1/4 Oz of starter per bird per day , or 2 pounds per bird in three weeks.

#### **How Long to Feed:**

Feed from Day 1 to Day 21, then switch to M0520 Organic Broiler Grower.

## **Broiler Grower/Finisher**

### **M0520**

#### **Guaranteed Analysis**

CRUDE PROTEIN	not less than	19.0 %

#### **Feed Description:**

Natures Best Organic Broiler Grower/Finisher is a 19% Crude Protein feed designed for chicks that are well started. It builds the frame and muscle, (meat). It is fully fortified for stress and will produce good gains with good legs for birds on pasture or in housing systems.

#### **How to Feed:**

Natures Best Broiler Grower/Finisher should be made available free choice to the birds at all times in clean feeders. Small amounts of granite grower grit may be fed on top of feed. Clean water should be available at all times. Scratch grains may be fed as a feed stretcher to older birds, however do not feed more than 10% of daily intake as it will reduce the protein level of the total ration. Protein is necessary to produce lean muscling.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

After consuming 2 Pounds of Natures Best Organic Broiler starter, amounts of Grower/Finisher will vary depending upon the breed of chicken, weather and temperature, and weight at marketing. Because of these variables, the birds will consume approximately 2 to 2-1/2 Pounds of feed per pound of gain. 6 pounds Grower/Finisher feed per bird from 21 days to 42 days is a good estimate.

#### **How Long to Feed:**

Feed from 3 Weeks of age to market.

## **Broiler Concentrate**

#### **Guaranteed Analysis**

#### **Feed Description:**

Natures Best 35% Organic Broiler Concentrate is designed to be mixed with ground corn to make a 19% Crude Protein feed for growing broilers that are well started. It builds the frame and muscle,(meat). It is fully fortified for stress and will produce good gains on strong healthy birds with good legs on pasture or in housing systems.

#### **How to Feed:**

Feed mixed with Natures Best Organic Broiler Supplement should be available in feeders at all times. Grower-size granite grit may be fed in small amounts, on top of feed. Clean water should be available at all times.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

After consuming 2 pounds of Natures Best Organic Broiler Starter, amounts of mixed grower will vary depending upon the breed of chicken, weather and temperature, and weight at marketing. Because of these variables, the bird will consume between 2 to 2-1/2 pounds of feed per pound of gain. 6 pounds of feed from 21 days to 42 days is a good estimate.

#### **How Long to Feed:**

Feed from 3 weeks of age to 6 or 7 weeks of age, or until market.

#### **How to Mix with Corn:**

Mix at the rate of 850 lbs. of 35% Organic Broiler Concentrate with 1150 lbs. of organic corn to make a complete 19% broiler ration.

## **Pullet Starter**

#### **Feed Description:**

Natures Best Pullet Starter is a 19% Crude Protein feed designed to get commercial pullet or backyard layer chicks off to a good start. It will provide good health and livability, and will build the legs and frame necessary for good laying hens without excessive fat.

#### **How to Feed:**

Natures Best Pullet Starter should be made available in chick feeders or feeder lids when chicks arrive. Keep feed in front of the birds at all times. Granite grit may be fed in small amounts, (a handful for 200 chicks on top of starter feed). Clean water should be available at all times.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

Chicks will consume approximately 2 -1/4 Oz of starter per bird per day , or 2 pounds per bird in three weeks. This will vary depending upon the strain or breed. of chicken. Follow this guideline unless your breeder or hatchery gives a different recommendation..

#### **How Long to Feed:**

Feed from Day 1 to Day 21, then switch to M0620 Organic Pullet Grower. If hatchery or breeder guidelines for a specific bird differ, follow their recommendation as to when to switch.

## **Pullet Grower**

#### **Feed Description:**

Natures Best Pullet Grower is a 17% Crude Protein feed designed to keep commercial pullet or backyard pullets growing. It will maintain good health and livability, and will build the legs and frame necessary for good laying hens without excessive fat.

#### **How to Feed:**

Natures Best Pullet Grower should be available in feeders at all times. Grower size granite grit may be fed in small amounts, on top of feed. Clean water should be available at all times.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

After consuming approximately 2 pounds of Organic Pullet Starter, feed at least 5.12 pounds of Organic Pullet Grower per bird.

#### **How Long to Feed:**

Feed from Day 22 to Day 70, then switch to M0630 Organic Pullet Developer. If hatchery or breeder guidelines for a specific bird differ, follow their recommendation as to when to switch.

## **Pullet Developer**

#### **Feed Description:**

Natures Best Organic Pullet Developer is a 15.5% Crude Protein feed designed to keep commercial pullet or backyard pullets growing, maintaining good health and building the legs and frame necessary for good laying hens without excessive fat.

#### **How to Feed:**

Natures Best Pullet Grower should be available in feeders at all times. Grower-Developer size granite grit may be fed in small amounts, on top of feed. Clean water should be available at all times.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

After consuming approximately 5 pounds of Organic Pullet Grower, feed about 6 pounds of Organic Pullet Developer per bird.

#### **How Long to Feed:**

Feed from 10 weeks to 18 weeks, or whenever you see the first eggs, then switch to M0654 16%, Organic Layer Mash, or M0650 16% Organic Layer Pellet.

## **Egg Layer Pellets**

#### **How to Feed:**

Natures Best 16% Organic Layer Pellet should be available in feeders at all times. Layer-size granite grit may be fed in small amounts, on top of feed. Feed Oyster Shell free choice to birds, as it is an excellent calcium source. Clean water should be available at all times.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

Birds should be consuming about 24 pounds of the complete mix per 100 laying hens, per day. If consumption is more than two pounds above or below this level, consult your Nature's Best service person.

#### **How Long to Feed:**

Feed from the day the first eggs are laid, throughout the life of the flock.

Natures Best 16% Organic Layer Mash is designed for producing laying hens. It is designed for birds consuming approximately 24 pounds of feed per 100 birds. It will provide the Organic layer flock with good health, good egg size and good egg numbers.

#### **How to Feed:**

Natures Best 16% Organic Layer Mash should be available in feeders at all times. Layer-size granite grit maybe fed in small amounts, on top of feed. Very small amounts of oystershell may be fed, but don't overdo it, as the feed already contains adequate levels of this excellent Calcium source. Clean water should be available at all times.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

Birds should be consuming about 24 pounds of the complete mix per 100 laying hens, per day. If consumption is more than two pounds above or below this level, consult your Nature's Best service person.

#### **How Long to Feed:**

Feed from the day the first eggs are laid, throughout the life of the flock.

It is designed for birds consuming approximately 24 pounds of feed per 100 birds. It will provide the organic layer flock with good health, good egg size and good egg numbers.

**How to Feed:**

Feed mixed with Natures Best Organic Layer Supplement should be available in feeders at all times. Layer-size granite grit may be fed in small amounts, on top of feed. Very small amounts of oyster shell may be fed, but don't overdo it, as the feed already contains adequate levels of this excellent Calcium source. Clean water should be available at all times.

**How Much to Feed:**

Birds should be consuming about 24 pounds of the complete mix per 100 laying hens, per day. If consumption is more than two pounds above or below this level ,consult your Nature's Best service person.

**How Long to Feed:**

Feed from the day the first eggs are laid, throughout the life of the flock.

**How to Mix with Corn:**

Mix at the rate 900 lbs. of 27% Organic Layer Concentrate with 1100 lbs. of organic corn to make a complete 16% layer ration.

**Duck Layer Feed**

Natures Best 16% Organic Duck Layer Feed is designed for producing ducks involved in egg production, such as Indian Runners, or Kahki Campbell's. It will provide the Organic layer duck flock with good health, good Egg size with strong shells, and good egg numbers.

**How to Feed:**

Feed Natures Best 16% Organic Duck Layer Feed should be available in feeders at all times. Layer-size granite grit may be fed in small amounts, on top of feed. Small amounts of oystershell may also be fed, free choice or on top of feed. Clean water should be available at all times.

**How Long to Feed:**

Feed from the first egg, throughout the production cycle.

**Scratch Feed**

**Feed Description:**

Natures Best 9% Organic Scratch Feed is designed to be fed in feeders or on the ground. The feed consists of coarse cracked corn, whole barley and whole wheat. It contains no added minerals, trace minerals or vitamins, so it should be fed only to free-range mature poultry that are receiving these nutrients from other sources, including the pasture.

**How to Feed:**

Feed should be available in feeders or spread on the ground at all times. Grower-size granite grit may be fed in small amounts, on top of feed. Oyster shell should also be offered, and clean water should be available at all times.

**How Much to Feed:**

Feed either free choice or vary the amount depending upon other additional feed fed.

## Turkey Starter

#### Guaranteed Analysis

#### Feed Description:

Natures Best 24% Organic Turkey Starter is designed to get newly hatched turkey poults off to a good start. It will help prevent starve outs and will get the birds started well. It is fully fortified for stress with the proper balance of amino acids, vitamins and trace minerals.

#### How to Feed:

Feed Natures Best Organic Turkey Starter right away, as soon as poults are placed in the brooders. . Put plenty of feeders and waterers in the brooder so that the poult almost stumbles on the feed. Egg flats pressed in the bedding and filled with feed serve well for this purpose. A small amount of chick size grit or some shiny marbles or aluminum foil will help attract the young turkeys to feed. Reduce the brooder temperature by about 5 Degrees per week. Feed should be available in feeders and flats at all times. Keep wet and soiled feed cleaned up. Clean water should be available at all times.

#### How Much to Feed:

Feed a total of 11 pounds of Nature Best Organic Turkey Starter per hen, and about 13 pounds of Turkey Starter per tom.

#### How Long to Feed:

Feed from day 1-51 for hens and from day 1-51 for toms.

## Turkey Grower #1

#### How to Feed:

Feed Natures Best Organic Turkey Grower #1 free choice in clean feeders. Keep feed available at all times. Feed small amounts of grower-size granite grit. Clean water should be available at all times.

#### How Much to Feed:

Feed a total of 6 pounds of Natures Best Organic Turkey Grower #1 per hen, and about fifteen pounds of Turkey Grower #1 per tom.

#### How Long to Feed:

Feed from day 52-65 for hens and from day 52-72 for toms.

## Turkey Grower #2

#### Feed Description:

**How to Feed:**

Feed Natures Best Organic Turkey Grower #2 free choice in clean feeders. Keep feed available at all times. Feed small amounts of grower-size granite grit. Clean water should be available at all times.

**How Much to Feed:**

Feed a total of 7 pounds of Natures Best Organic Turkey Grower #2 per hen, and about fifteen pounds of Turkey Grower #2 per tom.

**How Long to Feed:**

Feed from day 66-78 for hens and from day 73-91 for toms.

**Turkey Grower Pellets**

**Feed Description:**

Nature's Best Organic Turkey Grower Pellets are designed to finish turkeys, game birds, or broilers from the starter stage all the way to finish, with good legs, good weight gain, lean carcasses, and healthy birds with better feed conversions.

**How to Feed:**

Feed in well adjusted, clean feeders with clean water available at all times.

**How Much to Feed:**

Have feed available at all times. Amounts to feed will vary greatly depending upon finished size of the birds, sex of the birds, and breed of bird. With turkeys use 2 ½ to 3 pounds of feed per pound of live weight gain as an approximate reference.

**How Long to Feed:**

Feed from the end of the starter period, approximately six to seven weeks of age, up to market weight.

**Turkey Finisher #1**

**Feed Description:**

Natures Best 16% Organic Turkey Finisher #1 is designed to keep turkey hens and toms growing well, up to the finisher stages. It is fully fortified for stress with the proper balance of amino acids, vitamins and trace minerals. It will build a strong frame and good strong legs, and will build lean muscle.

**How to Feed:**

Feed Natures Best Organic Turkey Finisher #1 free choice in clean feeders. Keep feed available at all times. Feed small amounts of developer-size granite grit. Clean water should be available at all times.

**How Much to Feed:**

Feed a total of 7 pounds of Natures Best Organic Turkey Finisher #1 per hen, and about fifteen pounds of Turkey Finisher #1 per tom.

**How Long to Feed:**

Feed from day 79-90 for hens and from day 92-111 for toms.

## **Turkey Finisher #2**

#### **Feed Description:**

It is fully fortified for stress with the proper balance of amino acids, vitamins and trace minerals. It will continue to build a strong frame and good strong legs on toms, and will continue to build lean, efficient, muscle.

#### **How to Feed:**

Feed Natures Best Organic Turkey Finisher #2 free choice in clean feeders. Keep feed available at all times. Feed small amounts of developer-size granite grit. Clean water should be available at all times.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

Feed will vary depending upon market weight.

#### **How Long to Feed:**

Feed from day 91-Mkt. for hens and from day 112-Mkt. for toms.

## **Turkey Grower Concentrate**

#### **Feed Description:**

Natures Best 36% Organic Turkey Grower Concentrate is designed to be mixed with ground corn to make a 20% or an 18% Crude Protein feed for growing turkeys that are well started. Natures Best Turkey Grower Concentrate is designed to get started turkey poults growing well. It is fully fortified for stress with the proper balance of amino acids, vitamins and trace minerals. It will build a strong frame and good strong legs.

#### **How to Feed:**

1. To make a 20% Turkey Grower #1 add 912 pounds of Turkey Grower Concentrate to 1088 pounds of organic ground corn to make a one-ton batch. Feed a total of 6 pounds of Natures Best Organic Turkey Grower #1 per hen, and about fifteen pounds of Turkey Grower #1 per tom.
2. To make an 18% Turkey Grower #2 add 753 pounds of Turkey Grower Concentrate to 1247 pounds of organic ground corn to make a one-ton batch. Feed a total of 7 pounds of Natures Best Organic Turkey Grower #2 per hen, and about fifteen pounds of Turkey Grower #2 per tom.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

Feed Natures Best Organic Turkey Grower Concentrate blended with corn as above free choice in clean feeders. Keep feed available at all times. Feed small amounts of grower-size granite grit. Feed Turkey sized grit to larger birds. Clean water should be available at all times.

#### **How Long to Feed:**

1. If using as Turkey Grower # 1, feed from day 52-65 for hens and from day 52-72 for toms.
2. If using as Turkey Grower #2, feed from day 66-78 for hens and from day 73-91 for toms.

## **Pig Starter**

#### **Feed Description:**

Natures Best 16% Organic Pig Starter is designed to get baby pigs off to a good start. It is fully fortified for stress with the proper balance of amino acids, vitamins and trace minerals. It is designed to supplement the sow's milk and to serve as a complete ration for weaned pigs in the nursery.

#### **How to Feed:**

Feed Natures Best Organic Pig Starter right away, introducing small amounts of fresh feed daily during the first week. Continue to increase feed amounts as appetite and consumption increase, keeping feed fresh. Clean water should be available at all times. After weaning keep the pigs appetite sharp by underfeeding slightly for the first few days. Put a little feed in the feeder and let them clean it up, then after all pigs are looking for feed, keep the feeders filled.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

Feed a total of 50 pounds of Nature Best Organic Pig Starter per pig, depending upon sows milking ability and weanling's weight.

#### **How Long to Feed:**

Feed until pigs weigh at least 40-45 pounds.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

Feed continuously as the sole ration to young pigs over forty pounds.

#### **How Long to Feed:**

Feed until pigs weigh about 150 pounds or to finish weight for a leaner carcass.

#### **How Much to Feed:**

Feed continuously as the sole ration to young pigs over forty pounds.

#### **How Long to Feed:**

Feed until pigs weigh about 150 pounds or to finish weight for a leaner carcass.

#### How to Feed:

Feed Natures Best Organic Hog Supplement at a rate of one half to one pound of 38% Swine Supplement per head per day, or mix at the rate of 350-550 pounds per ton.

#### How Much to Feed:

Feed Nature's Best Organic Hog Supplement blended as above with ground corn to hogs weighing 40 pounds to market weight. Feed free choice. Keep feed in feeders fresh and clean.

#### How Long to Feed:

Feed until pigs weigh about 150 pounds or to finish weight for a leaner carcass.

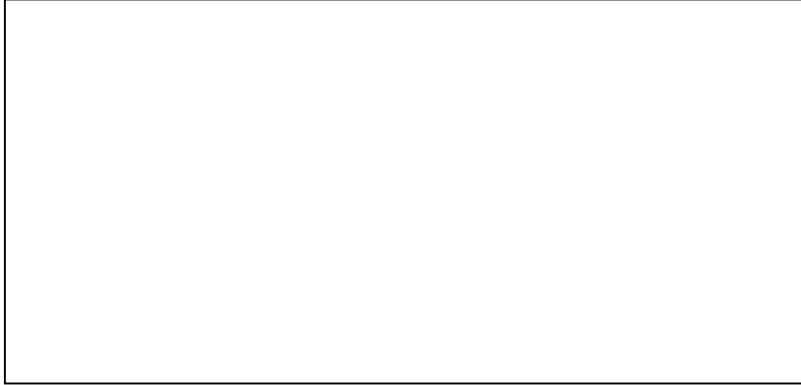
