To Whom It May Concern:

The Duluth area is fortunate enough to be sending a group of 15 and 16 year olds to the Senior Little League Regional Tournament in Columbia, MO this year. While there they will play a minimum of 4 baseball games against 9 other teams from the Midwest region. The dates for the tournament are August 7-11, 2010 with the winner moving onto the Senior Little League World Series in Bangor, ME the following week.

This trip will be very costly for our team and are asking for financial help through a donation. Little League is a non-profit organization and whatever you are able to donate is tax deductible. We are a 501 (c)(3) organization [41-1716595](#).

Written acknowledgment from the charity must include a description of the property or amount of cash donated plus a statement as to whether the donor received any goods or services (with a good faith estimate of value) in connection with the donation [[Reg. 1.170A-13\(f\)](#)]. If the donor received intangible religious benefits, the acknowledgment must say so, although no valuation of such benefits is required. Taxpayers must receive the acknowledgment before the earlier of (a) the date the return for the year of the donation is filed or (2) the due date, including extensions, for filing the return. The acknowledgment can be either a paper copy or in electronic format, such as an email addressed to the donor ([IRS Pub. 1771](#)).

Your donation will help defer some cost of the hotel and travel expenses for the players. We have 13 kids from the Western and Lake Park Little League organizations participating on this team. Checks should be made out to LPLL.
