Since its first antipoaching aircraft was put into operation in Zimbabwe in 1990, its aircraft have helped save human lives by providing air ambulance service to carry wounded and injured game scouts, the occasional injured tourist and injured and sick villagers from the bush to hospitals. Wilderness Conservancy has brought its experience home and is rendering humanitarian (healthcare and educational) services to indigent people in Baja California, Mexico. Today, it's retired antipoaching aircraft are filled with much needed medical equipment and supplies and flown to needy facilities for the poor and handicapped.

Shark Savers



Shark Savers is a non-profit membership organization dedicated to saving the sharks through building awareness, education, and grassroots action. Shark Savers is enabling people to learn, take action, share information, and find each other around the mission of saving sharks.

Please help stop Shark finning. Shark finning is a practice where sharks are caught, hauled on board, the fins sliced off, and then the still-living, finless bodies are tossed overboard. Unable to swim or breath by keeping in motion, the sharks endure a painful death from suffocation, blood loss, or predation by other species. It is estimated that 75-100 million sharks are killed each year for their fins.

Customs data shows that more than 100 countries are involved in the business of trading in shark fins. Most are exporters while the main consumer nations are mainland China, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Singapore, Taiwan, and Thailand. The United States and the European Union also import significant quantities to local Chinese communities.

While there are many causes for the decline in shark populations, shark finning is no doubt one of the main contributors. Shark finning is a worldwide problem that can only be solved by a conscious effort on a global scale. Sharks have been on our planet for 450 millions years and they could become extinct during our lifetime from consumption of a tasteless and nutrition less soup.
