

Ride to Scotty's Castle, Death Valley – March 14, 2009

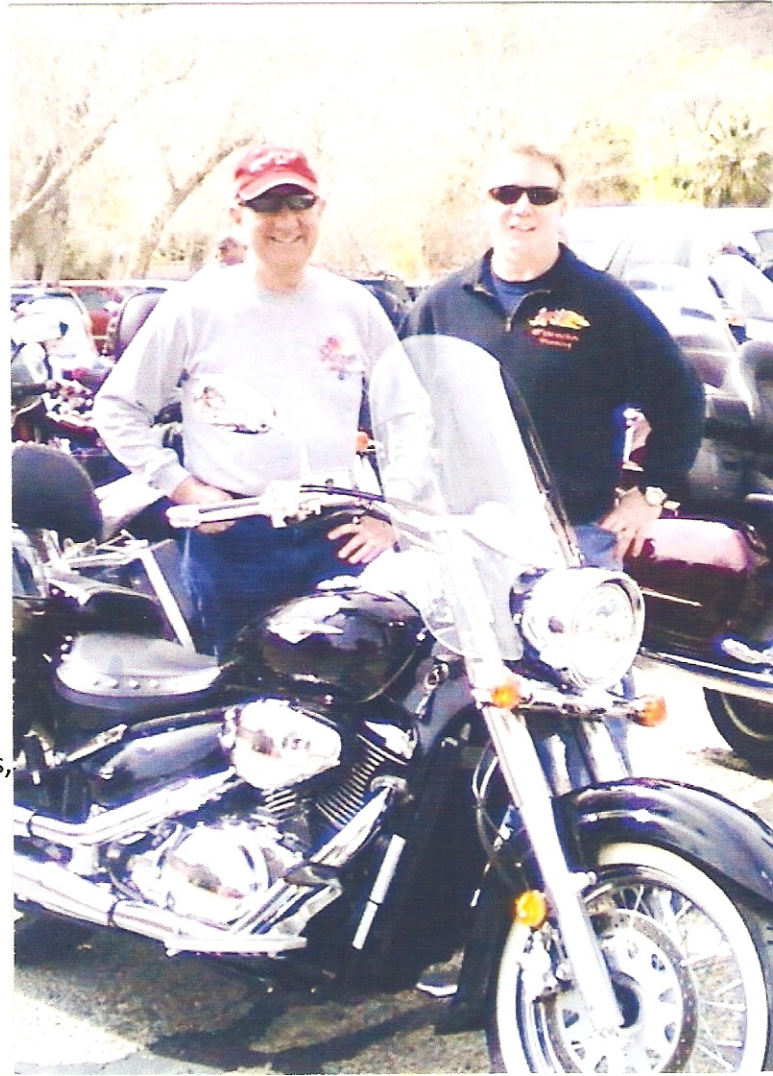
