

The South Carolina Tire Dealers and Retreaders Association Scholarship Program

The South Carolina Tire Dealers and Retreaders Association (SCTDRA) will provide limited assistance for South Carolina students who wish to pursue a higher education as well as students interested in pursuing a career in the tire industry. The objective of the scholarship fund is to provide assistance for formal education for the employees and/or family of dealer members.

Scholarship funds will be provided up to a maximum of \$500 for one semester of tuition and books. Funds will be paid to the institution for tuition and books only. It is the student's responsibility to provide SCTDRA with appropriate bills and documentation for payment. No funds will be paid to the student directly.

The Scholarship Committee of the SCTDRA will review all applications and make recommendations to the board of directors. Participating students must maintain an overall grade point average of 2.5 and a grade point average of 3.0 in all major topics to remain eligible.

In order to be eligible for the scholarship, **students must be recommended by a dealer member in good standing with SCTDRA.**

Requirements and qualifications may be added or deleted by the SCTDRA Board of Directors' as they deem necessary. Students may reapply each year, but first time applicants will receive preferential consideration.

Once an application has been received, it will remain on file and in contention until all funds have been expended. Applicants will receive letters of notification once his or her application has been either declined or approved.

Students in degreed programs will receive preferential consideration.
