BROBERG BREAKS OUT IN MILWAUKEE

St. Cloud, Minnesota December 22, 2009 – Justin Broberg had a breakout weekend for Warnert Racing when he took the win in Semi-Pro Open on Friday night. It was Justin's first win on the ISOC circuit and the first for Warnert Racing this season. The Waukesha, Wisconsin native has really started to show his talent this season with two podiums in the race last weekend and a strong ride in Semi-Pro Stock this weekend until a kicker caught him off guard and moved him back to 10th. With his smooth, disciplined style of speed, watch for Justin on his XPS sponsored sled to contend for more wins this season.

Backing up Justin's win was Dylan Martin in second on the DeWalt sled and Darrin Mees in fifth on the NSK backed machine. Both riders looked extremely strong as they battled into contention from the back of the pack, with Mees actually moving from 15th to the front.

In the Pro classes Steve Taylor, Tim Tremblay and Emil Ohman struggled with starts as they tangled with other riders almost every race, but charged hard through the pack to finish in the top 8 each final. All three racers have shown tremendous speed in the tough Pro division and expect to land on the podium soon. Team Owner Ron Warnert stated "These racers have shown great speed and stamina, we just need to get some better starts so they don't have to come from so far back"

Christian Salemark suffered a broken collar bone just before the season started and will return to action at the Shakopee, MN event.

The team has a couple weeks off for the holidays and is preparing for the race in Sandy, UT on January 8th & 9th as ISOC expands its venues towards the Western US. This is the first time the circuit has been to the Mountain states, and the racers are really amped up to visit a new stadium style track.
