## **TREMBLAY AND MEES SHINE IN THE EAST EASTERN SWING IS HOME TURF FOR SOME**

**St. Cloud, Minnesota February 8, 2010** – The ISOC Sno-Cross championship series headed east for the first of three stops which brought a couple of the team members closer to home. Tim Tremblay and Darrin Mees both come from the eastern parts of North America and grabbed some extra inspiration from racing closer to friends and family to score 2<sup>nd</sup> place podium finishes on Friday night and 4<sup>th</sup> place finishes on Saturday.

Tremblay had another strong, consistent weekend that started with the Friday night Pro Stock race. Tremblay ran good in his qualifiers, but went on a tear in the final as he moved from eighth to second before the checkered flag fell. Saturday was much the same as he ran well in qualifying and then moved from an eighth place start to finish 4<sup>th</sup> in the final. Emil Ohman had a roller coaster weekend running very strong in qualifying – never finishing worse than third – but in the finals bad luck bit him. In Pro Stock he tangled at the start and had to come from way back just to get to ninth, and in Pro Open he launched off a jump only to have a sled stall in front of him and upon landing – crashed hard enough to do serious damage to the snowmobile. Christian Salemark injured his leg Friday and was hobbled throughout the rest of weekend, while Steve Taylor couldn't find his stride and didn't qualify for the finals

In the Semi-Pro classes the racers had another good weekend with steady results, finishing just short of the win. Darrin Mees put on two spectacular charges through the field, the first on Friday night brought him home in second place, and only seven tenths of a second from first. Justin Broberg backed him up with a third place finish and Dylan Martin came home fifth. Broberg's finish moved him into the points lead for the Semi-Pro Open season championship.

Mees put together another blazing run on Saturday in Semi-Pro Stock – starting the race in twelfth place and charging to fourth at the finish. Broberg came home sixth and Martin had a minor off causing him to drop way back in the final.
