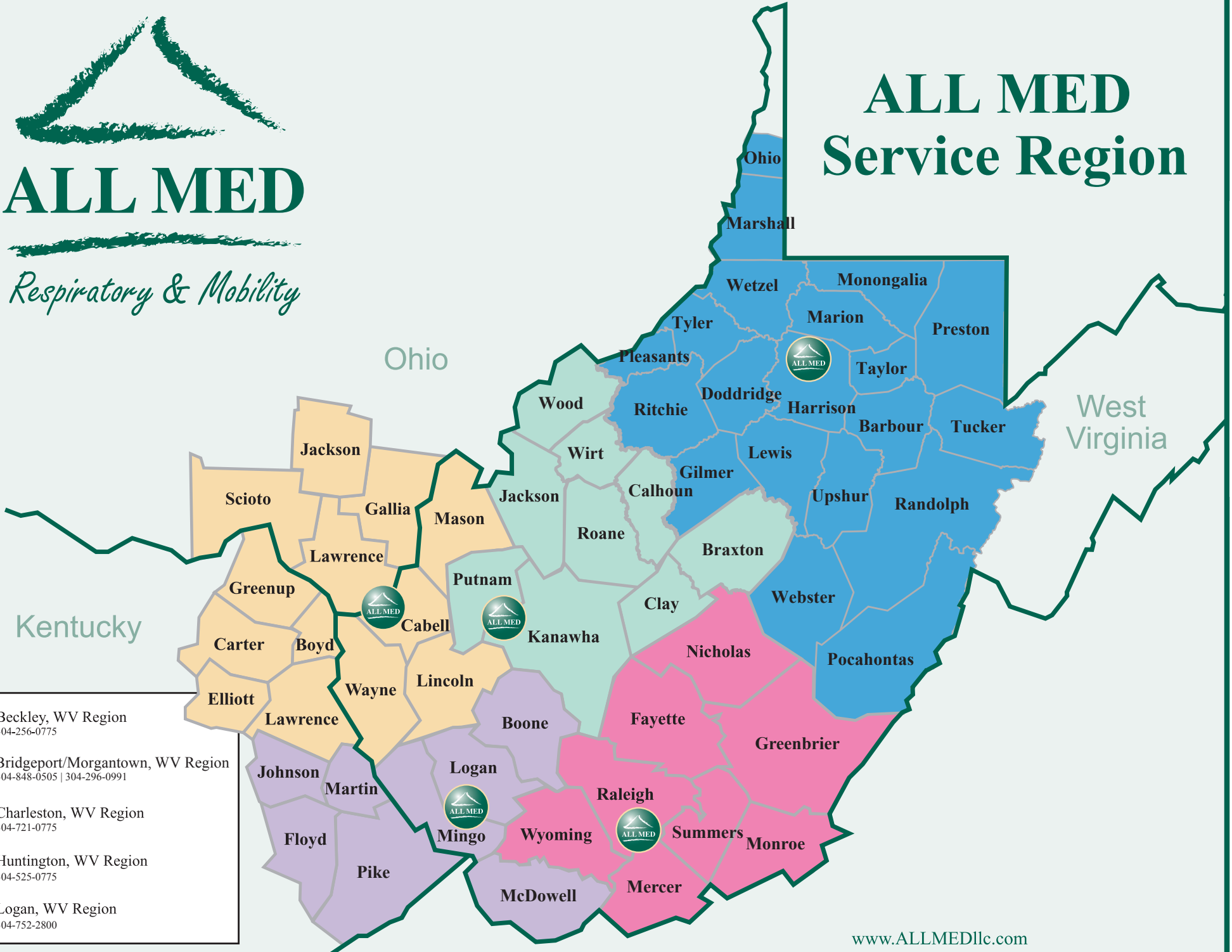

## Home Medical Equipment

Reimbursement Qualifications / Common Diagnoses

**Home Fill Oxygen System:** Patient must have a Room Air ABG = PO<sub>2</sub> of < 55 OR a Room Air Pulse Ox = SAT of < 88 (Nocturnal only O<sub>2</sub> available with sleeping SAT of < 88).

COPD 496, Emphysema 492.8, CHF 428.0, CAD 414.0, Pulmonary Hypertension 416.0, CA of Lung 162.9, Pleural Effusion 511.9, Interstitial Lung Disease 515, Hypoxia 799.0, Respiratory Distress 786.09, Respiratory Failure 518.81, Cor Pulmonale 416.9, etc.

**Semi-Electric Hospital Beds:** Patient requires immediate repositioning to alleviate pain, smothering, aspiration, edema / assist in wound care / aid in transfer to wheelchair. None of this feasible in an ordinary bed.

COPD 496, CHF 428.0, Chronic Pulmonary Heart Disease 416, Aspiration 934.9, G / J Feeding Tube V44.1 / V44.4, Osteoarthritis 715.09, Rheumatoid Arthritis 714.09, Paraplegia 344.1, Quadraplegia 344.0, CVA 436, MS 340, MD 359.1, Parkinson's 332, ALS 335.20, Malignant Neoplasms, Renal Failure 586, etc.

**Support Surfaces (Prevention & Therapy):** Prevention overlays: Patient meets criteria for hospital bed, has limited ability to reposition themselves in bed, and is susceptible to skin breakdown. Therapy systems: Patient must have multiple stage II ulcers or a single stage III or IV on their trunk. Generally they have tried other prevention systems and have failed / worsened.

In general, the same diagnoses that qualify a patient for a hospital bed that have lent to the patient being susceptible of / or having active decubitus ulcers.

**Lightweight Wheelchairs:** Patient can no longer safely ambulate with a cane, walker, etc... The patient cannot functionally propel themselves in a standard weight chair (50lbs) but they can in a lightweight (30lbs).

**Motorized Wheelchairs:** The patient can no longer functionally ambulate or propel a manual wheelchair enough to care for themselves independently in their home. A thorough evaluation of the patient and their home environment must be done to ensure they receive the appropriate chair.

In general, the same diagnoses that qualify a patient for a manual wheelchair. You must show in your evaluation (done by an OT, PT or Physician) the patient has a neurological disorder, and/or has multiple debilitating diagnosis, and/or lacks the strength to propel a manual wheelchair and/or is compromised by chronic pain, and/or falls often, and/or doesn't have the pulmonary or cardiac function to be independent, etc.
